OF RS. 1,31,16,00.

Reference your memo No.14/21-2001 SE(3) dated 23.5.2001 dated
4.6.2001 the subject noted above.

Sanction of the Government of Haryana is hereby accorded to the
issuance of administrative approval for inclusion of the scheme cited in the
subject in the schedule of new expenditure PLANSIDE for the year 2002-2003.
on the following conditions:-

1. Finance Department agree of the AD's proposal for upgradation of 23 High Schools to the level of Senior Secondary Schools, 22 Middle Schools to the level of High Schools and creation of 46 Middle Schools.
2. The FD's approval to the upgradation of the Schools mentioned above is sanctioned w.e.f. 1.4.2002 and the Department may take all necessary preliminary steps during the intervening period. The Department should also get the necessary budget provisions made in this respect at this stage itself.
3. The Department is also advised to complete the exercise in rationalization of teaching staff especially in the caegories of Lecturers and Masters within a definite time frame, preferably before the close of the current financial year and apprise the FD about the results of such rationalization exercise.
4. The expenditure would be debitabale to the following Heads:-
 - A) "2202 General Education-01-Elementary Education-101- Government Primary Schools (Plan) expansion of facilities (Ful Time) Classes VI to VIII.
 - B) "2202 General Education-02-Secondary Education-109-Government Secondary School (Plan) Expenditure of facilities institutional classes IX- XI.

No. D.D.o. Head of Institution will make the purchases. The Drawing and Disbursing Officers should insure that the amount mentioned in the sanction should be utilized strictly according to the conditions laid down in Govt. sanction and in this endorsement and clarify the expenditure as Plan/Non Plan expenditure.
